# Filters

*Filters are the hidden 💎💎💎 present inside the text formats, And they control how the field content on the site gets displayed.*

## Enabled filters

- Limit allowed HTML tags and correct faulty HTML
- Display any HTML as plain text
- Convert all Email-Addresses to MailTo links.
- Convert line breaks into HTML (i.e. <br> and <p>)
- Convert URLs into links
- Align images
  - Uses a data-align attribute on <img> tags to align images.
- Caption images
  - Uses a data-caption attribute on <img> tags to caption images.
- Restrict images to this site
  - Disallow usage of <img> tag sources that are not hosted on this site by replacing them with a placeholder image.
- Correct faulty and chopped off HTML
- Track images uploaded via a Text Editor
  - Ensures that the latest versions of images uploaded via a Text Editor are displayed.

## Filter processing order

- ⊕ Convert all Email-Addresses to MailTo links.
- ⊕ Align images
- ⊕ Caption images
- ⊕ Correct faulty and chopped off HTML
- ⊕ Track images uploaded via a Text Editor
